Checklist when leaving



When leaving the hall please ensure the following is checked:

- Floors are swept and any spills mopped mop and bucket in the kitchen. Blue paper
 rolls can be used. There is also a cleaning cupboard in the Gents Toilets the key is in
 the cupboard in the kitchen above the dishwasher. Please put out a Warning Sign for
 wet floor.
- All **bins** are emptied and rubbish taken away with you unfortunately we are not on the council collection list.
- Toilets are clear of rubbish and suitably clean for next use. No nappies left behind.
- Windows and doors shut and lights switched off (lights in the toilets automatic switch off)
- **Central heating** thermostat (above hatch in the hall) returned to target temperature of 10 degrees if changed.
- **Kitchen** (if used) clean, work surfaces wiped down and items **returned to the correct** cupboards. The cupboards are labelled. 'Touch points' need to be cleaned and sanitised before leaving the kitchen (oven, microwave, hatch handle etc). Please make sure that the cooker, dishwasher etc are switched off, clean and empty
- Chairs and Tables are clean and stacked neatly away big tables by the entrance
 door to the main room. Round and small tables in the lobby. Chairs around the sides
 of the hall where the signs are NOT behind the stage or in front of the radiators (it
 blocks the heat) or emergency exits or fire extinguishers. Max stack x7 chairs. Blue
 chairs live in the lobby.
- **Key** is returned to the keysafe. Please make sure it is shut properly and not left open during the hire. We've found that if rain gets into the box it hinders it's workings.
- Lights there are two marked buttons in the lobby that light inside and outside lights that can help when leaving in the dark. They use a timer and automatically switch themselves off.

Please ensure the hall is left in a condition suitable for the next use. If there are any problems with the condition upon arrival then please take a photo and contact:
